Located on the end of Welch Community Hospital in McDowell County, The HOPE Rehabilitation Center serves individuals with addiction issues that also have an underlying minor medical condition preventing treatment for addiction issues in less intensive programs.

Our program is designed to serve individuals, both male and female, with addiction issues by providing 24-hour services for adults struggling with substance use and mental health disorders.

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We provide Case Managers who assist with connecting our consumers with longer term inpatient Substance Use Treatment, Outpatient SA and MH Treatment AND referrals once consumers are discharged from our program such as housing and employment including connecting consumers families with various needed resources in the community. Our Peer Recovery Support Specialists are available for those struggling adding the layer of support our consumers need to help fulfill their long-term goals.



We provide Direct Support Specialists that assist our consumers during their residential stay 24 hours. Our consumers are provided with protective oversight, prepared meals, and make certain that our program, as well as physical needs of the consumer are met.

Additionally, our program provides linkage to services to continue on the right care plan and evidence-based programs to address the specific needs of each client served, individual and group mental health and addiction counseling. Our skilled staff has specialized training in practices and techniques to work in the populations, in which we serve, to provide HOPE towards a better future.
