### **April - June 2025 Training Topics and Descriptions**



#### Courses marked with this symbol are courses required to meet the voluntary, Child Care Credential/Specializations criteria.

Attachment and Behavior: Child Growth and Development (Beginner)

Do you have children with challenging behavior in your care? In this training by Carrie Frasch, you will learn and understand the characteristics of secure and insecure child attachment and the effects attachment can have with children's behaviors.

#### Early Childhood Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (ECPBIS): Child Growth and Development; Child Observation and Assessment; Environment and Curriculum (Advanced)



In this training by Meredith Lester, you will learn about Early Childhood Positive Behavior Intervention and Support. Participants will learn about positive ways to support the children in their care and manage behaviors they see in their programs. At the end of the modules participants will be able to understand that positive intervention is an effective tool for

managing behavior. You must attend all 3 sessions.

#### **Emergency Preparedness:** Health, Safety and Nutrition (Beginner)



In this session with Sami Cochran, participants will learn about and discuss the types of emergencies that have and can occur while children are in care and planning needed to keep children and workers safe during those events. Participants will receive support in

creating the required emergency preparedness action plan.

#### Infant/Toddler Positive Intervention and Supports (ITPBIS): Child Growth and Development, Child Observation and Assessment, Environment and Curriculum (Advanced)



This class by Carrie Frasch will teach providers the importance of building relationships with infants and toddlers and to identify various strategies that can be used to support positive behaviors. Participants will learn to: understand social emotional development, behaviors,

form sustaining relationships, understand the importance of environmental design, structure transitions, routines, expectations, and engaging activities to do with infants and toddlers. You will receive materials throughout the module series to help you implement the new strategies you will learn. You must attend all 3 sessions.

#### Infant/Toddler Environment Rating Scale (ITERS)-3: Child Growth and Development; Environment and Curriculum (Beginner)

To promote the optimal growth and development of infants and toddlers, caregivers need to be able to identify and recognize the various components of a quality program. ITERS-3 is the Third Edition of the Infant Toddler Environment Rating Scale, which is a tool that identifies key elements that can help caregivers assess what areas they are thriving in and what they can do to reach a higher level of quality. This training will introduce ITERS-3, compare the difference from previous versions, educate caregivers on how to use the tool and discuss the benefits of using it in classrooms.

#### **Tackling Transitions:** Environment and Curriculum (Beginner)

In this training by Meredith Lester, you will learn how to have seamless transitions in the classroom. Participants will learn about how to engage children during transitions to minimize disruptive

behaviors. At the end of the session participants will be able to understand how to transition children calmly and positively.

**<u>The Growing Brain:</u>** Various Core Knowledge Areas (Beginner)




This 7-session series delves into research in brain development and strategies for childcare providers to support the growing brains of children, birth to 5 years old. The crucial development of the growing brain is one of the most important topics in early childhood

development. Research on the topic is exploding, underscoring the need for early childhood professionals to stay up to date on brain development and strategies to best support the growing brains of children, birth to 5 years old, in their care.

West Virginia Elements of Family Child Care Series: Various Core Knowledge Areas (Intermediate)

The WV Elements of Family Child Care Series was developed for Family Child Care and Facility providers to improve the quality of early childhood education. This seven-module series focuses on topics ranging from becoming a professional and organizing your day to

what children are learning and how to work with families. You must attend all seven sessions to get credit for this course. Contact your local TRAILS team for more information.





The Division of Early Care and Education sets the billable days based upon the number of possible work days in each month. The child(ren) must have attended the site at least one day during the month to be eligible for the full billable day's payment. If children attend more than the set number of billable days, actual days of attendance may be billed. If a child attends two different providers during the month, actual days of attendance must be billed.

Providers shall not deny access to care to any child for whom they receive payment by enrollment.

Billable days for the upcoming months:

April 2025 - 22 days

May 2025- 22 days

June 2025 – 21 days









# Earn Your Breastfeeding-Friendly Child Care Designation



The West Virginia Breastfeeding-Friendly Child Care Designation (BFCCD) is a voluntary program that offers resources to child care providers who support breastfeeding mothers. The designation is open to all licensed child care centers, registered facilities and family child care providers who choose to participate. Providers who enroll in this initiative will receive support from Infant/Toddler Coaching Specialists, Child Care

Nurse Health Consultants, and Child Care Health Educators. Upon completion of the 10-step process, your site will receive materials to support start up, a certificate of designation, and a stipend.
